Safe cooking of burgers – consultation response

In September 2004 the ACMSF agreed to set up an *ad hoc* group to review the current advice on the safe cooking of burgers. The draft report of this group was discussed at the ACMSF meeting in June 2006 and approved for public consultation. The consultation took place between July and October 2006. Comments received in response to the consultation were considered by the *ad hoc* Group (Annex A) and several minor amendments were made to the Report (Annex B).

- (ii) Approve the revised report provided at Annex B and agree that the Report on the safe cooking of burgers should be submitted to the FSA Chair for approval for final publication by June 2007.
