## PROGRESS REPORT ON THE WORK OF THE CAMPYLOBACTER WORKING GROUP

## **Meetings of the Working Group**

- 1. Since the ACMSF last met, its *Campylobacter* Working Group has held one meeting, on 23 May 2003.
- 2. The principal item of business at that meeting was the consideration by Members of a partial draft of the Group's report. The Group has made good progress elaborating the core of its report. Aspects covered by the draft included:-
  - the disease, human immune response and pathogenesis;
  - Campylobacter epidemiology;
  - measures to prevent *Campylobacter* contamination of poultry meat;
  - measures to prevent *Campylobacter* cross-contamination in domestic and catering environments; and
  - detection and typing.
- 3. Further work is required both in relation to some of these aspects and in other areas (eg. the measures to prevent *Campylobacter* contamination of meat other than poultry meat).

## **Future work programme**

4. The Working Group expects to make further substantial progress with the drafting of its report over the Summer. The aim is to have a draft ready for consideration by the full Committee at its 18 September 2003 meeting.
