The Agency has published a review of how people manage food safety in their homes and what implications these behaviours could have on their health. This project was commissioned as part of a package of work to investigate people's behaviours in relation to food safety in home. It complements a series of questions in the Food and You survey and further qualitative/observation research the Agency is undertaking in 2011. The study draws on existing evidence and interviews with experts in the field to explore what is already known about food safety in the home, how this topic has been explored in the past and where there are gaps in the evidence base.
