FSA FOOD HYGIENE DELIVERY PROGRAMME

The Food Hygiene Delivery Programme (FHDP) was established to prioritise, direct and measure progress in an ambitious and comprehensive programme of work to improve food hygiene delivery and enforcement across the UK, covering all foodborne pathogens and all food groups. It was set up to drive forward actions to respond to the recommendations of the Public Inquiry into the outbreak of *E. coli* O157 in Wales in 2005.

The FSA will give an overview of work under the FHDP, including progress on phase 1 of the Programme which is nearing completion. An outline of the recently completed evidence review on regulation cultures and behaviours, which will inform future work on the FHDP, will be presented. An update on discussions on the FHDP at the Agency's September 2010 Board meeting will also be provided.

The attached September Board paper provides further background on the FHDP.
